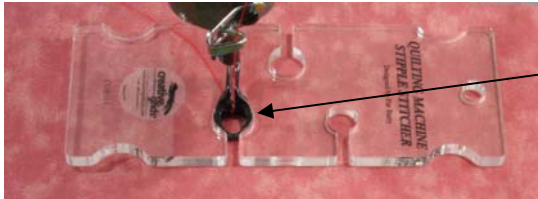
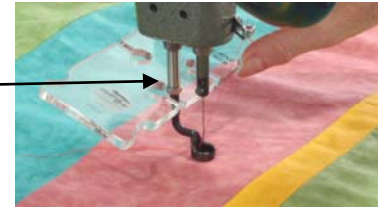


How to Use the Quilting Machine Stipple Stitcher

Position the Stipple Stitcher.

1. Slide the template around the shank of the foot.
2. Lower the template to fit around the hopping foot.



It should be snug enough to guide the machine but loose enough to allow the foot to move up & down without interruption.

Hold the template using the finger grips.

The Stipple Stitcher becomes an alternative set of handles that you use to guide the machine with your fingertips, not your full hand. By using your fingertips, you can get the fine motor control that you need for micro-stippling and other detail stitching.



Reminder:

Check your machine foot. The hopping foot should be round and fit into one of the three circular openings. These 3 sizes will fit most longarm and midarm quilting machines.

The template must also be thick enough to prevent it from slipping under the hopping foot when sewing.
